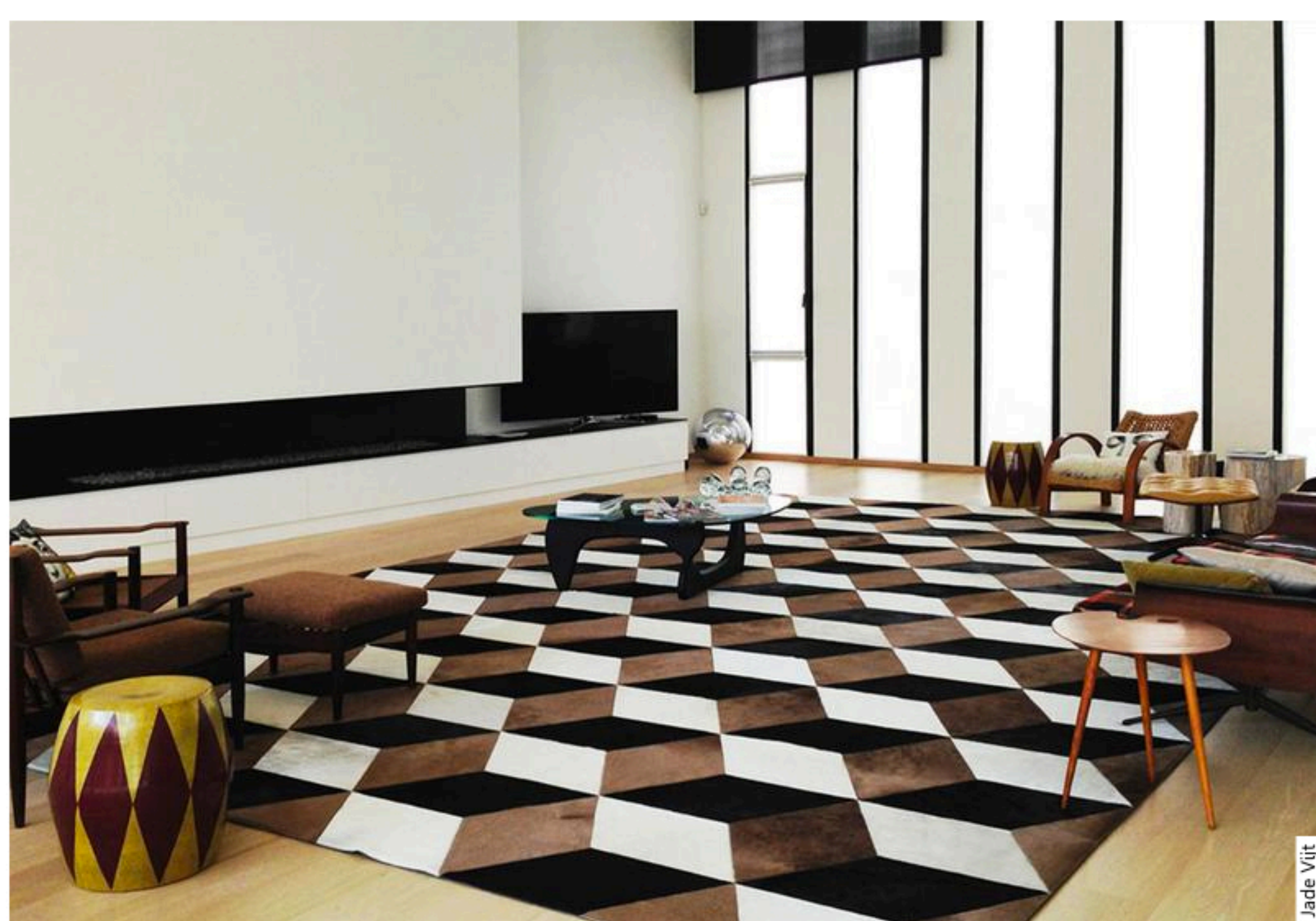

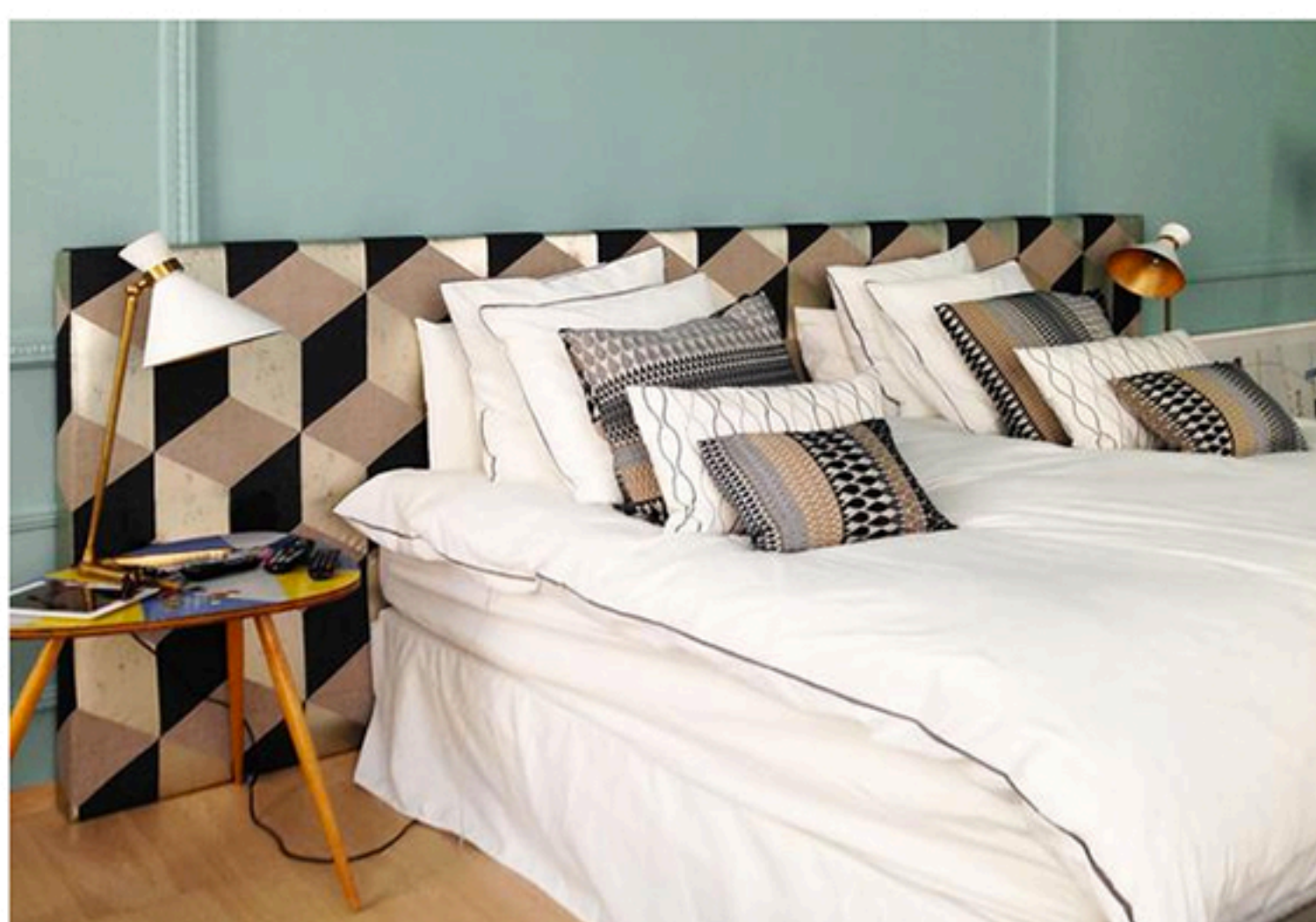
Noble residence in Brussels undergoes bold renovation by Jade Vijt

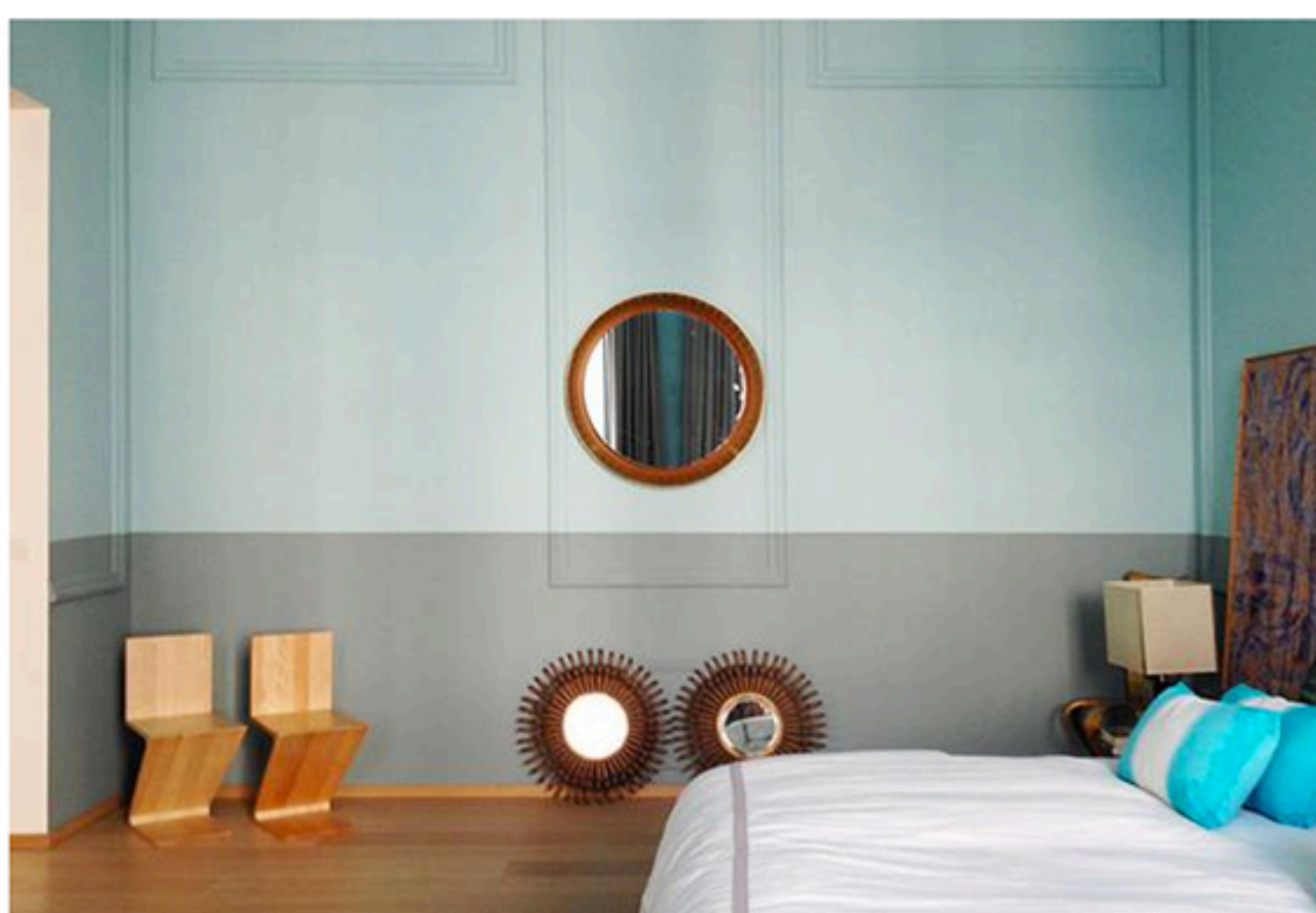

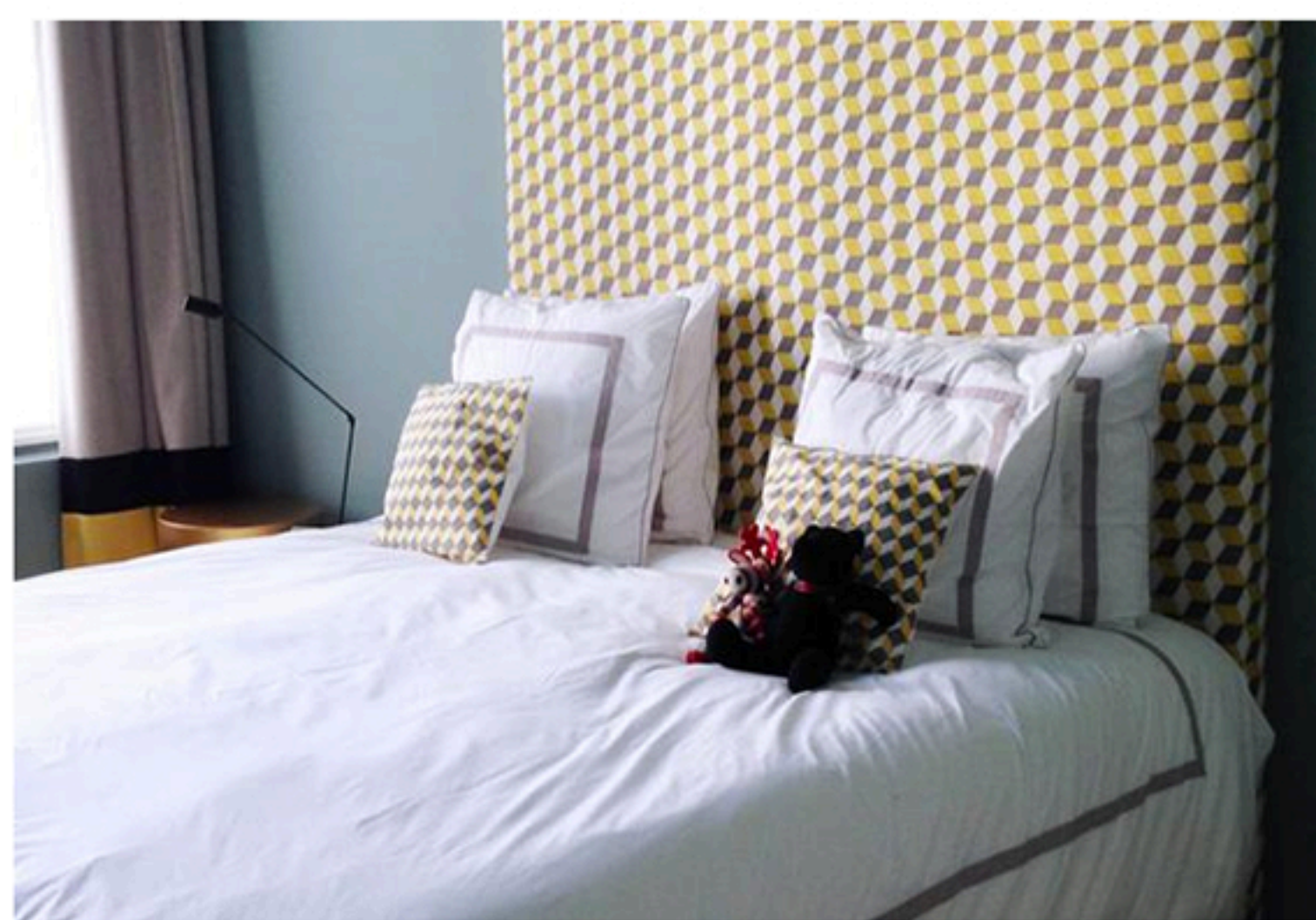

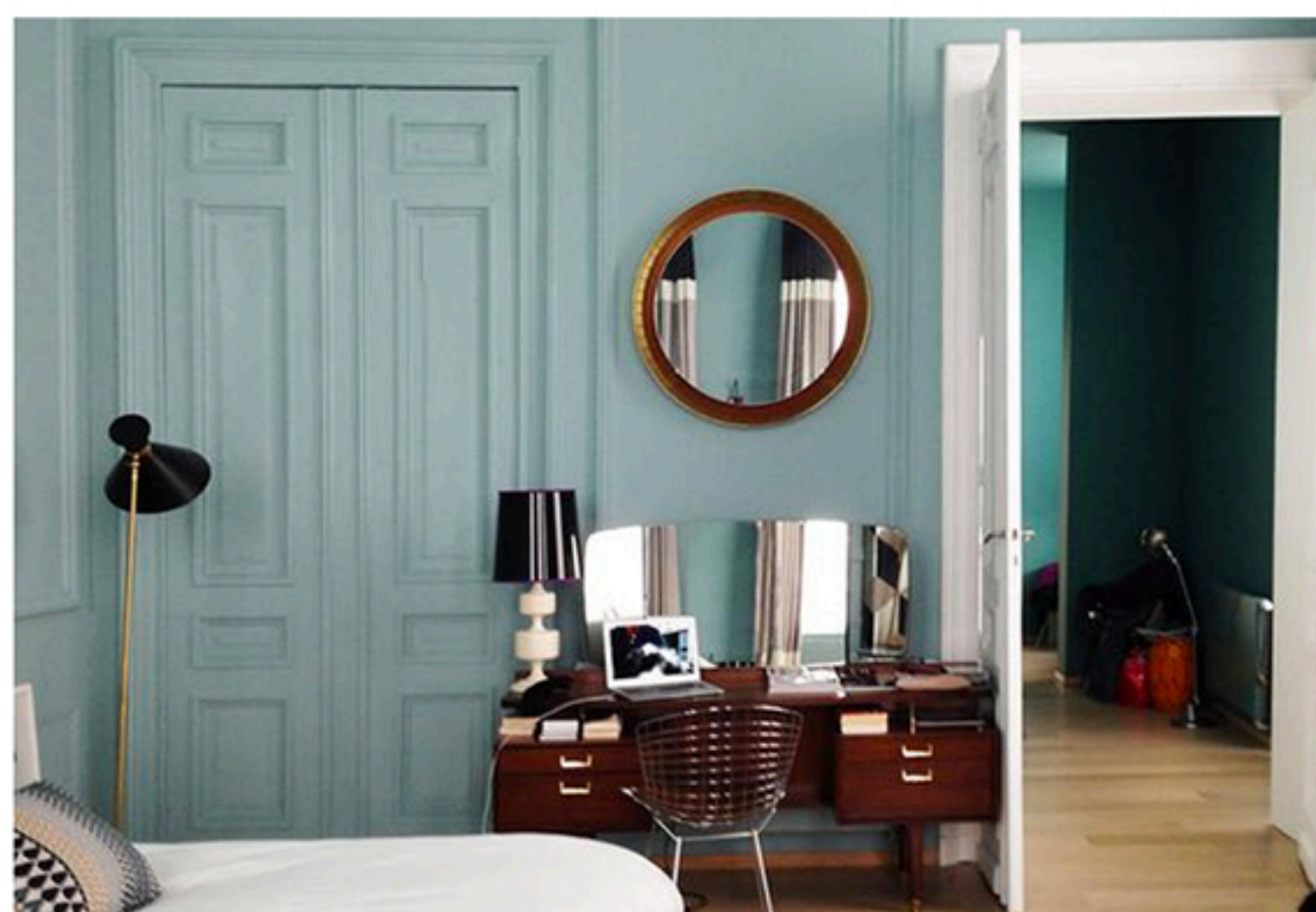


Forget the Baroque decorations and opulent knick-knacks, and welcome lurid-coloured coffee tables with three-leg base, 60's-inspired curvy sofas, optical-patterned carpets, and a couple of Gerrit Rietveld's ZigZag chairs reminding us how near Netherlands is.



A modernist approach drives the use of colours, both for the furniture – spiced up with the occasional ochre and green hints – and sfumato walls.
